Subject: establishment of a tourist tax for the Municipality of Capannori, from 1 April 2026.

Dear Guests,

The Municipality of Capannori, by Council Resolution No. 9/2026, has introduced a tourist tax in accordance with Article 4 of Legislative Decree No. 23 of 14 March 2011. This tax aimed at financing projects aimed at strengthening the local tourism sector, improving the promotion of the area, enhancing services and promoting the artistic and cultural heritage.

The tax is due to come into force on 1 April 2026.

This communication provides the main information regarding the application of the tourist tax, and we invite all those interested to consult the official website of the Municipality of Capannori (www.comune.capannori.lu.it) for further details.

The tourist tax is payable by all non-residents of the Municipality of Capannori who stay overnight in accommodation facilities located within the municipal area. It applies for each night of stay, from 1 January to 31 December, up to a maximum of three consecutive nights in the same accommodation facility.

The tax applies for a maximum of **3 consecutive overnight stays** at a rate for person for night of:

- €2.50: 1/2/3-star hotels
- € 3.00: 4/5-star hotels
- € 1.50: campsites and hostels
- € 2.00: non-hotel sector and agritourism

The following exemptions apply:

- a) minors up to the age of fourteen;
- b) a bus driver and a tour guide accompanying groups of no fewer than 25 people;
- c) persons caring for patients admitted to healthcare facilities within the municipal area, for a maximum of two people per patient;
- d) persons staying in the Municipality of Capannori to undergo treatment at healthcare facilities located within the area, and one companion per patient;
- e) non-self-sufficient disabled persons and companions associated with the disabled person;
- f) military personnel and members of the police forces or corps, as well as members of the National Fire Brigade and the National and Regional Civil Protection Corps, who are staying overnight for exclusive service needs;
- g) individuals staying in accommodation facilities following measures adopted by public authorities to address social and emergency situations following disasters or extraordinary events, or for humanitarian relief purposes.
- h) students regularly enrolled in university, conservatory, secondary school, higher education, professional training courses, in institutions located within the municipal area, provided that their stay exceeds three consecutive nights.
- i) staff employed by the accommodation facility who work there;
- j) individuals hosted by accommodation facilities at the request of the municipal administration for the purposes of promoting and developing the city or for climatic or health emergencies
